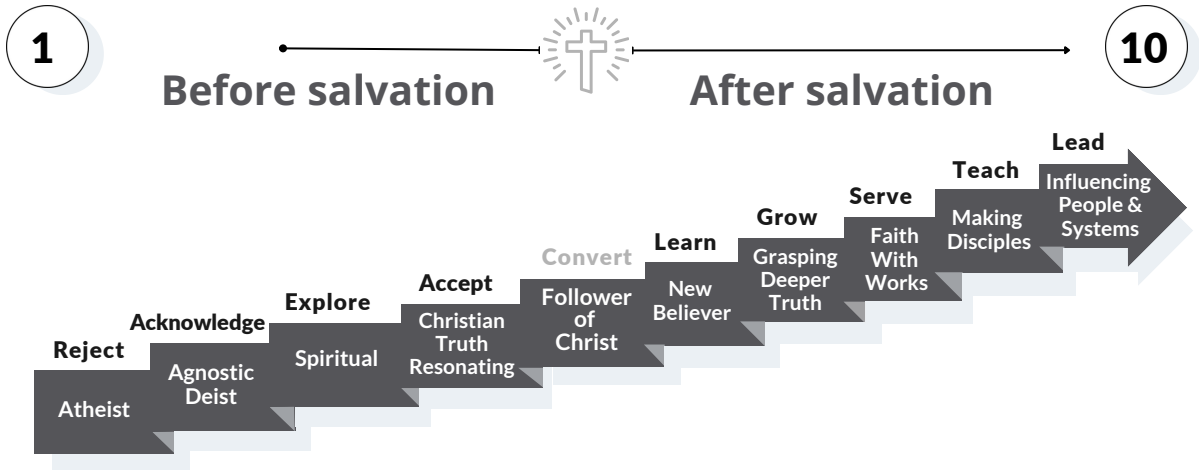
Online Missionary Helpful Hints

What is Discipleship?



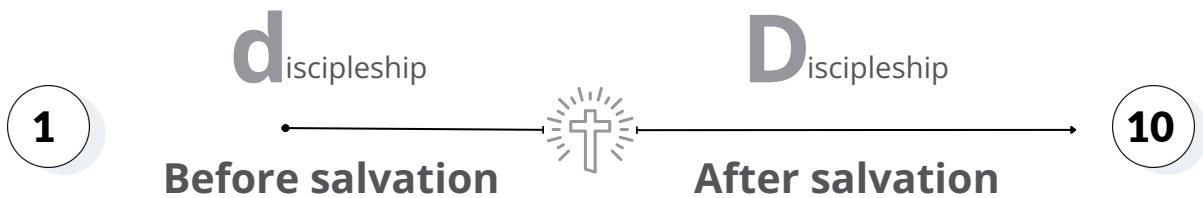
A disciple
is an ongoing Contact who has indicated a desire for continued spiritual growth.

Discipleship can occur at any point in a Contact's spiritual journey. Either before or after salvation.



This distinction is what we call

"**Little d**" discipleship and "**Big D**" Discipleship.

“Little d” discipleship

This is discipling *unto* Salvation.

Many of these disciples are interested learning who Jesus is, and what following Him means.

Our hope is that they will turn to Jesus as they are introduced to Him through guided questions and conversation.

We must help them to get to know God and recognize their need for Him. Only then can they trust Him and give their life to Him, accepting His gift of Salvation.

“Big D” Discipleship

This is discipling *after* Salvation.

Through conversation with your ongoing Contact, verify their decision to follow the Lord.

Continue in relationship together as you help them grow and share prayer concerns with one another.

Our end desire is “Big D” Discipleship.

But, we must first engage in “little d” discipleship with many of our Contacts.
