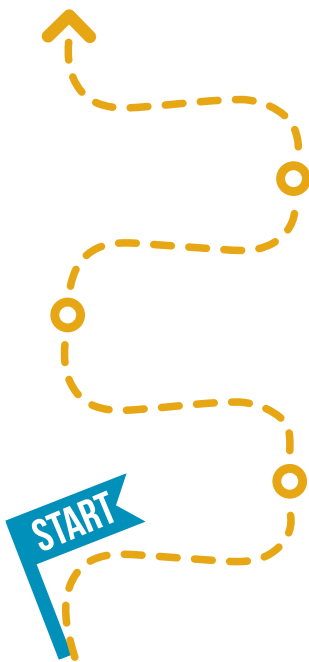

What is the Spiritual Growth Tool?

- The Spiritual Growth tool gives you a framework to follow with your Contacts as you begin a journey of discipleship.
- It allows you to be intentional in your conversations and offers milestones to move toward.
- Tracking growth allows you, and the ministry, to see how your Contact's relationship with the Lord grows over time.

What information do I record in the Spiritual Growth Tool?

Use the Spiritual Growth tool to record your Contact's progress in 6 areas of their faith journey:

When and how to use the Spiritual Growth Tool

- Begin tracking a Contact's spiritual growth when they have agreed to keep in contact with you for prayer and spiritual growth.
- If they agree to this, you will also mark them as a disciple at this time. They can now be easily found in your Disciple's list.

Update the Contact's spiritual growth profile as you continue work through various content pieces such as the New Believer's Guide or Bible Studies.



Ask open-ended questions related to content you have shared together, to help determine your Contact's stage in each of these areas.



Do not use the Contact's initial Indicated Decision to mark Salvation. Ask questions to dig deeper and find evidence of their understanding and relationship with Christ.

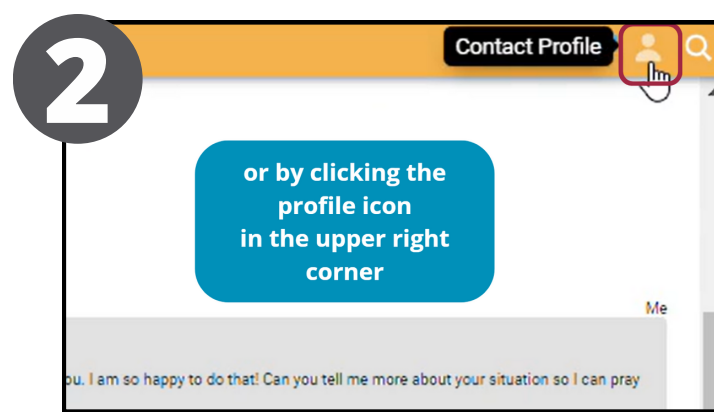
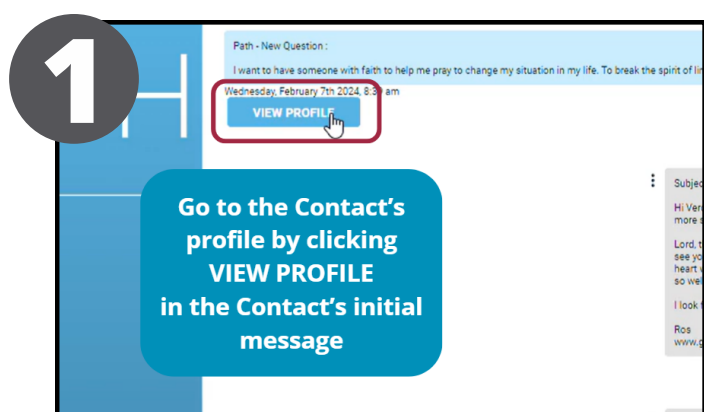
